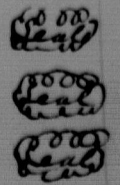


and sell unto and to the use of the said Perryville Water Com-

 First, all that hereinafter described portion of what is known
 as the Abrahams Mill Property located in the seventh election district
 of Cecil County in the State of Maryland beginning for the
 same at a point in the bed of the Mill race on the northern-
 most side of the Philadelphia division of the Baltimore and
 Ohio Railroad where the same passes through the tract of land
 known as Ellerslie and formerly owned by a certain Henry S.
 Comdow and at the westernmost and Susquehanna end
 of the Strip of mill race which runs parallel with and on
 the northernmost side of said railroad thence running up
 said mill race toward mill creek including all of said
 mill property of every description to the northward and eastward
 of the place of beginning as well as all the rights ways waters
 privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 any wise appertaining and free and clear of and released from
 any and all rights ways waters privileges and appurtenances
 in any wise belonging to or connected with that portion of said
 Mill property on the susquehanna side of or below the
 place of beginning herein and not conveyed hereby. The
 property herein conveyed being all of the lands or property
 to the northward and eastward of the place of beginning herein
 conveyed to the said W Arthur Stump by the said James J
 Graham by deed dated the second day of July 1892 and recorded
 among the land records of said Cecil County in Liber J G No 2
 folio 74. Second, the right to lay and maintain water pipes
 or mains in the bed of the old Post Road between Principio
 Furnace and Perryville where the same passes over or in front
 of the lands of John Stump being all the rights conveyed to said
 W Arthur Stump by said John Stump and Mary A Stump
 his wife by deed dated May 28th 1892 and recorded among
 the land records of said Cecil County in Liber J G No 2
 folio 73 together with all the rights ways waters privileges
 and appurtenances belonging to all or any of the pieces
 or parcels of land herein conveyed or in any wise appertaining
 thereunto. To Have and To Hold the same unto and to the
 use of the said Perryville Water Company of Cecil County its
